Job Title: Instructional Coach, STEM

Job Summary

Position is responsible for implementing a comprehensive STEM Magnet program at Discovery STEM Academy through establishing and maintaining a STEM Learning Ecosystem that develops STEM literacy through a cross-sector approach, maintaining a program infrastructure that supports future-ready teaching and learning for all, coordinating extracurricular programming aligned to innovation and entrepreneurship, and by coaching, supporting, and guiding teachers in best practices/pedagogies for integrative STEM/STEAM instruction.

Essential Duties

1. Coaches and supports teachers in planning, delivering, and assessing quality STEM/STEAM instruction.
2. Supports teachers by conducting frequent classroom visits, observing STEM/STEAM instruction to assess need, planning for instruction, modeling, co-teaching, consulting, leading guided reflection, and offering supportive and specific feedback to teachers as needed.
3. Assists teachers with classroom organization, materials procurement, and STEM-based learning activities that support identified targets and objectives.
4. Leads interdisciplinary planning sessions in order to develop cross-curricular inter- and trans- disciplinary learning experiences.
5. Demonstrates self-reliance in mastering new technologies such as robotics, online instructional programs, and basic coding.
6. Communicates with internal and external STEM stakeholders.
7. Coordinates student internships and field experiences.
8. Collaborates regularly with STEM Instructional Supervisor, STEM Instructional Specialists, school-based Instructional Technology Coach and building administrators to address areas of greatest need.
9. Analyzes data to determine benchmarks, establish goals, and monitor improvement in assigned areas and develops concrete steps within the school, department, or classroom to address identified needs.
10. Supports the work of teams by attending and participating in team meetings as needed.
11. Attends and participates in monthly division and school-based leadership meetings and trainings.
12. Leads magnet recruitment and updates promotional materials as needed.
13. Assists curriculum writing teams and STEM Instructional Supervisor in the revision and development of curriculum and assessments.
14. Plans effective professional development to support teacher learning around curriculum, technology, and STEM pedagogies.
15. Demonstrates a basic knowledge of state and national STEM-related standards, and the ability to model and employ science/engineering practices and computational thinking skills.
16. Attends and participates in professional development to improve and maintain knowledge of content, instructional strategies, coaching skills, and adult learning theory.
17. Keeps detailed records related to all aspects of the position.
18. Models nondiscriminatory practices in all activities.

Other Duties

1. Keeps abreast of developments, research, and technology in the area of STEM, including instructional best practices and a deep understanding of national and state standards.
2. Performs any other related duties as assigned by the STEM Instructional Supervisor or appropriate administrator.

Job Specifications

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodation may be made to enable individuals with disabilities, who are otherwise qualified, to perform the essential functions.

Minimum Qualifications (Knowledge, Skills and/or Abilities Required)

Must possess a Bachelor’s degree and be eligible for an appropriate Virginia teaching license. Advanced degree and/or education certifications in STEM preferred. Must possess at least 5 years of effective teaching experience, preferably across levels/contents, and demonstrate documented success in the area of integrative STEM education. Experience as a departmental head, lead teacher, or a related instructional leadership position required. Must possess an in-depth knowledge of STEM research and instructional best practices/pedagogies. Must possess effective instructional delivery methods and the ability to guide and train teachers in effective techniques and strategies. Must possess excellent organizational and communication skills. Must possess the ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with teachers, administrators, and students.

Working Conditions & Physical Requirements

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodation may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform essential functions. Must have the ability to sit and stand for extended periods of time; exhibit manual dexterity to dial a telephone, to enter data into a computer terminal; to see and read a computer screen and printed material with or without vision aids; hear and understand speech at normal classroom levels, outdoors and on the telephone; speak in audible tones so that others may understand clearly in normal classrooms, outdoors and on the telephone; physical agility to lift up to 25 pounds; to bend, stoop, climb stairs, walk and reach overhead.
