Job Summary

Position is responsible for monitoring and assisting students while at recess.

Essential Duties

- 1. Oversee outside play and/or activities
- 2. Monitors student behavior to ensure a safe play environment
- 3. Report incidents and accidents through established forms and procedures.
- 4. Provide feedback of student discipline observations to the classroom teacher(s) and/or administrative staff.
- 5. Models nondiscriminatory practices in all activities.
- 6. Attend and participate in Recess Monitor meetings and training sessions as required.
- 7. Other duties as required by the Principal.

Job Specifications

Demonstrate fair, consistent, and sound judgement when coping with conflicting situations. Apply knowledge and experience of health and safety requirements.
