Newport News Public Schools (NNPS) Preschool is a program that provides 4-year-olds in Newport News a free, high-quality, early childhood experience in preparation for kindergarten readiness (and beyond!). It is a state and federally-funded program, designed to give eligible children opportunities to develop social-emotional skills and build a strong foundation for learning on the journey to becoming college, career and citizen-ready!

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About NNPS Preschool:

- A FREE full-day program for eligible Newport News children
- Every class is taught by a certified teacher, supported by a full-day instructional assistant, and does not exceed 20 students
- Children are assigned to a school based on the home address of the child's parent/guardian
- Parent/Guardian participation is expected; open communication, parent-teacher conferences, and family workshops/activities are integral as part of a positive school experience
- Transportation is provided by NNPS; bus stops at daycare providers may be available if the location is within the assigned school zone
- Breakfast and lunch are provided by NNPS

Eligibility Requirements for NNPS Preschool:

- Live in Newport News, VA
- Born between October 1, 2020 and September 30, 2021
- Meet Virginia Preschool Initiative (VPI) or NNPS Preschool eligibility requirements (all criteria can be found on the NNPS website)
